- Share the results / products of this grant with the MAGIC Region.

Preference will be given to those who include a letter from the home state's Geographic Information authority endorsing the project.

Official MAGIC reports must be submitted to the MAGIC Grant Committee by the following submittal dates to remain in good standing in order to receive the entire MAGIC Grant amount awarded.

- January 12, 2018 - 1st Progress Report Due
- April 1, 2018 - 2nd Progress Report Due
- April 22-26, 2018 - Presentation at the 2018 MAGIC Symposium
- July 1, 2018 - 3rd Progress Report Due
- August 31, 2018 - Last Date To Request Grant Fund Payment
- October 1, 2018 - Completion Report Due
